Directions to The Presbyterian Church of New Brunswick 100 Livingston Avenue, New Brunswick, NJ (732) 545-2111

From the New Jersey Turnpike: Take Exit 9. Follow the signs for Route 18 North. Take the New Street exit. Take New Street to Livingston Avenue. Turn left on Livingston Avenue. Go four blocks: 100 Livingston Avenue will be on the left at the corner of Townsend Avenue. Turn left onto Townsend Avenue. Make a left into the parking lot at the rear of the church.

From the Garden State Parkway: Take the Parkway to Exit 130. Follow Route 1 South to Route 18 North. Take the New Street exit. Follow directions underlined above.

From Route I-287: Follow Route I-287 to Exit 10 (Easton Avenue.) Follow Easton Avenue until it ends. (You will pass St. Peter's Hospital and travel under the railroad overpass next to the train station.) At the light at the end of Easton Avenue (next to the train station) make a left onto Albany Street (Route 27.) At the 1st traffic light make a right onto George Street. Go five blocks: 100 Livingston Avenue will be on the left at the corner of Townsend Avenue. Turn left onto Townsend Avenue. Make a left into the parking lot at the rear of the church.

From Route 27 North: Stay in the left-hand lane as you cross the bridge after leaving Highland Park. At the 2nd traffic light (at the Hyatt Regency Hotel), make a left onto Neilson Street. At the first traffic light make a right turn onto New Street. Take New Street to Livingston Avenue. Turn left on Livingston Avenue. Go four blocks: 100 Livingston Avenue will be on the left at the corner of Townsend Avenue. Turn left onto Townsend Avenue. Make a left into the parking lot at the rear of the church.

From Route 27 South: After the light at the railroad station, stay in the right-hand lane. At the 1st traffic light (after the train station) make a right onto George Street. Go five blocks: 100 Livingston Avenue will be on the left at the corner of Townsend Avenue. Turn left onto Townsend Avenue. Make a left into the parking lot at the rear of the church.

Directions to Johnson Park, Piscataway, NJ

Route 287: Take Exit 9 (Highland Park). Follow River Rd. toward Highland park (2 miles). After Johnson Dr., the park begins on your right. Park runs parallel to River Rd.

Route 1: Take exit for Route 18 North. Take Exit for Highland Park/Route 27 North. Make left at traffic light onto River Road. Park begins on the left at 1st traffic light (Cedar Lane). Park runs parallel to River Road

NJ Turnpike: Take Exit 9 (New Brunswick). Take Rt. 18 North. Take Exit for Highland Park/Route 27 North. Make left at traffic light onto River Road. Park begins on the left at 1st traffic light (Cedar Lane) Park runs parallel to River Road.

Garden State Parkway: Take Exit 129 (NJ Turnpike). Take NJ Turnpike South. Follow directions for NJ Turnpike.
