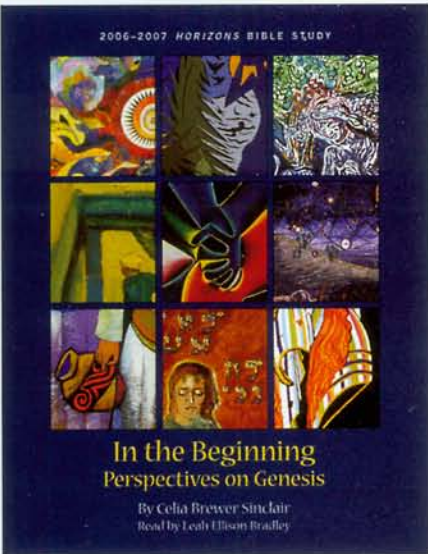

This is the First Presbyterian Church of Batchersville, built in 1867 and moved to the present location in 1931 when the gates at the Conklinville Dam were closed and the Sacandaga valley began to be flooded. In 1959 the church joined with Northville Presbyterian Church and since that time it has become our outreach mission. Every July and August we hold regular services here so that summer visitors and residents will have a place to pray.

After tireless work by many, the church, in 1996, was placed on the register of American Presbyterian/Reformed Historical Sites. In 2000 the Church was added to the state and national Registry of Historical sites. Our doors are open all summer, come visit us.



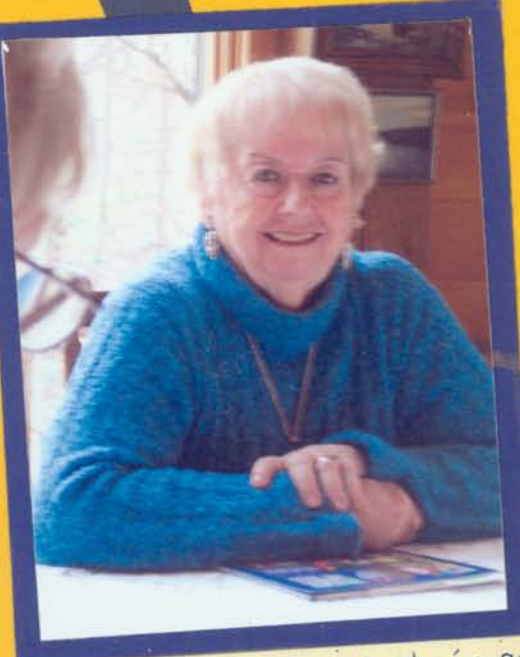
Donna Breda, our treasurer reports on our many mission works. PW raised \$596.00 for the World Hunger drive.
